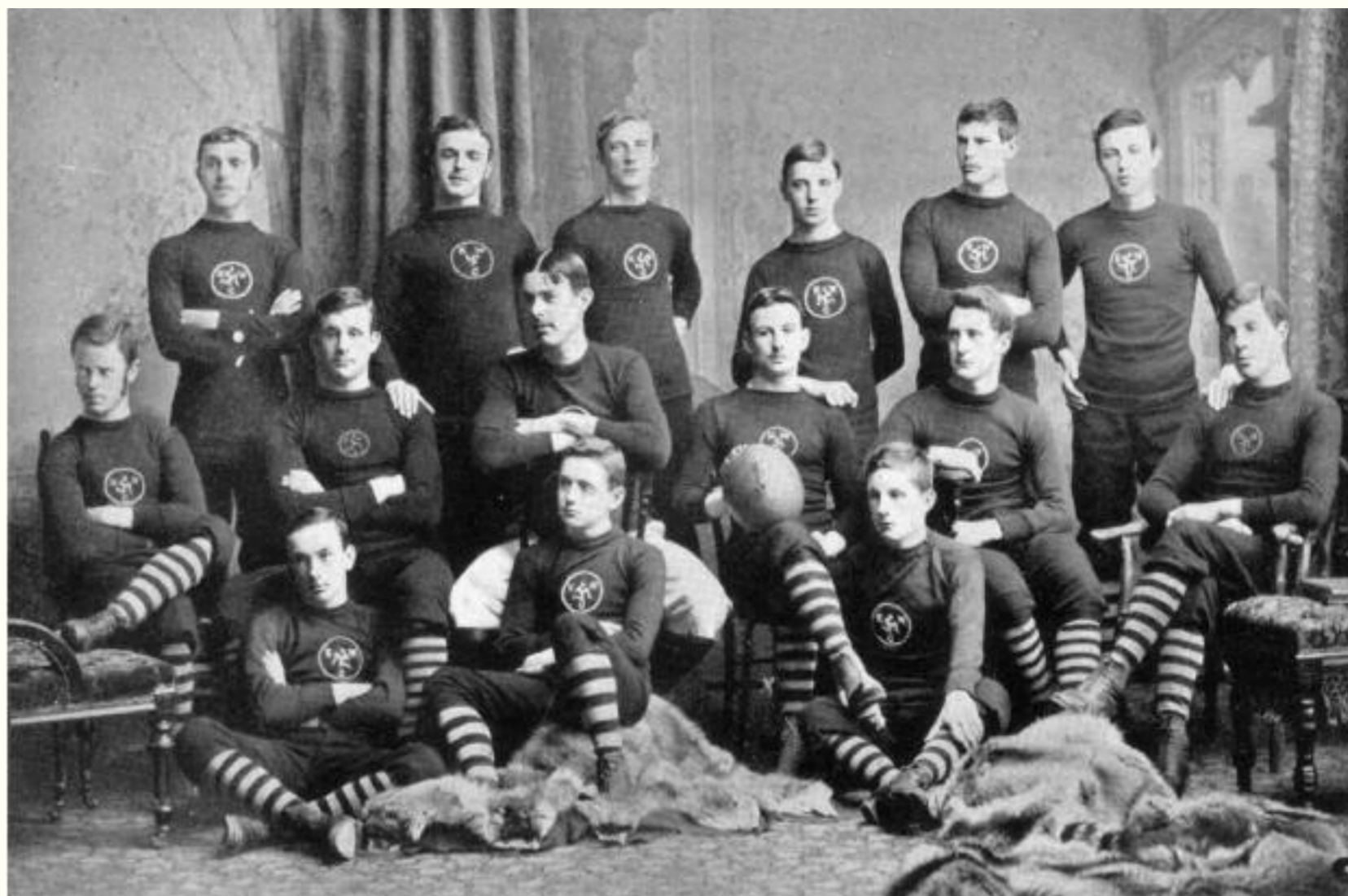


College Rugby

There are records of XV's playing rugby at the College in The Barrovian Magazine of 1880. Matches were few and far between and it was common for the masters to play in the XV until 1898. The earliest photograph of the 1st XV, taken in 1883, shows them wearing a black jersey with an unusual crest, the 3 Legs of Man and the letters KWC. The black jerseys have remained ever since but the College arms have long ago replaced the old crest.
